There is a total of 80 children. We have prayers for our covenant partners and for the sick on Thursdays. We still have our men, women and youth meet in special days within the week.

We are challenging Satan who is trying to hinder our progress with regards our church development. There are many difficulties to the normal functioning of our activities. Most of our members survive on agriculture. We have a small project to help sustain the church of raising cattle. We have 5 heads of cattle at the moment; fruit of the initial 2 or helped us start. The idea is to have a cart and plow that will help in aspects- transporting people to hospital and to fetch water and also in agriculture. We will ask that your prayers help us get these materials so that the project can start.
